Dear Parents and Students:

Welcome to Wilson's Summer Reading List for 2018! Summer reading is intended to encourage students to read and keep their skills honed for the school year. We ask students fill out a **reading log for each book** and have it signed by a parent/guardian. Each student is **required to read TWO books of the student's choice either from the 2018-2019 Sunshine State Young Reader's List or the Alternative Choices List.** Students will take an assessment and participate in related activities in their Language Arts/Reading classes for books read. If you register for school late, talk to your language arts teacher or reading teacher about this requirement as soon as possible.

STEPS FOR SUMMER READING:

All grade levels select two books from the following lists (An annotated list of novels is located on the Wilson Website, wilsonms.mysdhc.org/.)

Use the reading logs attached for the books you read. These should be turned in to your 2018-2019 Language Arts/ Reading teacher.

Credit will only be awarded if the log includes the "Response" and the required parent signatures verifying the books were read by the student.
